Same Day Ultrasound Services Save More Lives

Providing an ultrasound to an expectant mother is one of the most important life-affirming services offered at Care Net Pregnancy Services of Northern Kentucky. We are happy to announce that because of your support, 98% of the women who were provided an ultrasound in 2018 chose life for their unborn babies! We are excited to provide even more opportunities for women and men to choose life in 2019 by providing "Same Day" Ultrasound Services.

It is anticipated that 41% more lives will be saved from abortion by providing same day ultrasound appointments.

Care Net began offering life-affirming ultrasound services in 2006 for a few hours a week. In 2016, ultrasound services expanded to one day a week at the Florence and Cold Spring medical locations. Knowing that on average women who have an ultrasound at Care Net choose life for their unborn babies 90 to 98% of the time, *we could potentially increase lives saved* by providing same day ultrasound services at both medical centers during our open hours.

God's timing and our prayerful intentions have come together in 2019 to begin offering same day ultrasound appointments. As anticipated, in January 2019, ultrasounds increased 110% to women who were abortion minded and undecided about their pregnancies over our 2018 January statistics. Our challenge is to fund the increase in medical personnel necessary to provide this

service. Both the Cold Spring and Florence medical center locations have increased current medical staff hours and are in the process of training three additional medical personnel. *We need your financial support to help us fund this life impacting effort.*

Care Net is dedicated to the sanctity of human life by providing life-affirming services to women and men at a time of uncertainty. Our efforts for the future include a first time capital campaign that will change, save and heal lives by stabilizing and acquiring adequate and appropriate facilities to expand our medical services and client support programs. Changing, Saving & Healing Lives Campaign Update

In 2018 Care Net launched its first-ever capital campaign entitled “Changing, Saving and Healing Lives”. This is Care Net’s first attempt in a direct appeal to our donors and the community to fund specific mission needs. Through the campaign, we are seeking five-year pledges and one time gifts. To date we have one time gifts and pledges of over \$760,000 toward our \$1 million campaign objective. Specific needs include:

A. \$400,000 for debt elimination of our Cold Spring center.

Paying off this mortgage will allow Care Net to utilize rental income from

space we are currently leasing to empower and sustain new and relevant medical services.

B. \$400,000 to facilitate relocation of our Florence Medical Center.

This is our busiest medical center operation which must be relocated because the current space is no longer adequate.

Currently, Care Net assists more clients in Florence than our other two locations combined.

C. \$100,000 for relevant medical services to promote sexual health.

This improvement will increase our ability to share the message of abstinence through screening, testing and

treatment of sexually transmitted diseases. This is a new program for Care Net and research supports our mission as being extremely relevant in reaching more people and saving lives.

D. \$100,000 for Marketing and Development. In order to maintain our development financial stability, we must allocate ten percent of our campaign objective to supplement related campaign marketing and development costs.

These campaign initiatives are critical to our mission as we enter the second year of our five-year campaign.

To date, current funding and initial pledge payments have allowed us to cover campaign operational expenses and plan for the strategic payoff of the Cold Spring mortgage. Assuming the timely and successful redemption of campaign pledges, the Care Net board of directors has projected the Cold Spring debt could be retired by as soon as March of 2021!
